PRESS RELEASE

MILITARY CONVOY ON TRANS-KALAHARI HIGHWAY

1. The Ministry of Defence (MOD) hereby announces that Botswana Defence (BDF) Force military equipment convoy will be moving from Walvis Bay on the Trans-Kalahari Highway to Mamuno Border post as from 09-10 May 2018.
2. The equipment are on transit from Botswana Dry Port to their main land. This is a well coordinated exercise which BDF applied for transit permit and for assistance with escort duty.
3. The escort is under the supervision of Namibian Defence Force Military Police and is divided into different packets with time intervals in between to allow normal traffic flows on the Trans-Kalahari Highway.
4. Members of the public are urged to drive safely and not to panic when they come across the unusual military convoy on the Trans-Kalahari Highway. The Ministry of Defence apologise for any inconvenience during this time especially to road users along the Highway.
